Brochures, envelopes, junk mail, printing paper, magazines, newspaper, paper ream wrappers.

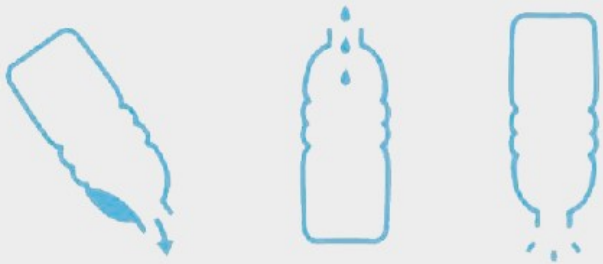
